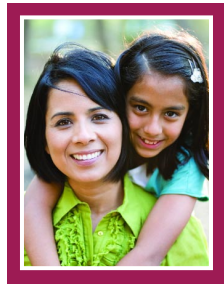

Moms on the Run® is an event designed to give busy mothers the break they need and deserve! Events are held at a church, community center, or other location. Child care is provided on-site. The atmosphere is fun and casual and the cost is affordable.

The purpose of Moms on the Run is to give mothers a place to invite neighbors and friends to take part in a topical dialog about practical aspects regarding their stage of life—plus respond to a personal faith story and Gospel presentation.

Moms on the Run is presented by Stonecroft Ministries—an international, nondenominational, nonprofit Christian organization whose goal is to connect women with God, each other, and their communities.

The 1½ hour schedule provides time for interaction and time to present content with real take-home value.

A typical program would include:

- Light refreshments and connecting time
- Practical, informative topic, related to parenting, marriage, and family
- Interactive discussion
- A speaker who transitions from the topical information to a Gospel presentation, concluding with an invitation to pray and receive Jesus Christ.

Follow-up is offered through Stonecroft Bible Studies. Other opportunities for future small group connections are also presented, such as special interest groups and community service opportunities.
